K3

Three-Year-Old Kindergarten

Language Arts	Recognition of name, sound, and picture for short vowels and consonants Language development and listening skills that include color words, shapes, animals, transportation, countries, community helpers, health, safety, manners, science, 23 poems, and finger plays memorized
Writing	Formation of vowels and consonants in upper and lower case, writing of first name
Numbers	Simple counting 1-50 Number concepts 1-15
Bible	Lessons such as: Creation, Noah, Boy Samuel, Daniel, Boyhood of Jesus, Zacchaeus, Good Samaritan, hymns and choruses, and 14 Bible verses memorized

K4

Four-Year-Old Kindergarten

Language Arts	<i>Phonics and Reading</i> Recognition of name, sound, and picture of long and short vowels and consonants Sounding of blends and one & two vowel words Reading of sentences and stories with one & two vowel words <i>Poetry</i> Twenty-eight poems and finger plays committed to memory <i>Language</i> Language development and listening skills that include color words, shapes, animals, transportation, countries, community helpers, health, safety, manners, and science
Cursive Writing	Formation of letters, blends, and words Writing of first name
Numbers	Number recognition and counting 1-100 Number concepts 1-20 Numbers before and after 1-20 Numbers largest and smallest 1-20 Addition facts
